In 2017, we provided

\$441,000

in financial assistance to children, teens, families, and seniors to help them participate in Y programs.

14,370

1,103

children were provided with the tools, skills, and academic support to succeed in school and life in all of our after school programming.

of these kids received a scholarship or DSHS assistance.



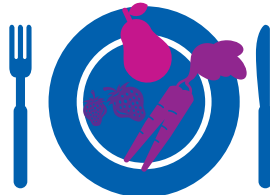
Over 140

5,837

meals are served per month to children in the Early Learning programs. In some cases, this is the only healthy food the children receive.



4,213

showers were provided to the homeless in our community, which is valued at **\$16,852**.



STRENGTH & CONFIDENCE

are the two most commonly mentioned achievements by graduates of LIVESTRONG at the YMCA. **\$12,500** was subsidized by the YMCA for three 12-week sessions for post-treatment cancer survivors.

Our wonderful volunteers donated **14,411** hours of service.
