PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The YMCA's Diabetes Prevention Program helps adults at high risk of developing type 2 diabetes reduce their risk for developing the disease by taking steps that will improve their overall health and well-being. Research by the National Institutes of Health has shown that programs like the YMCA's Diabetes Prevention Program can reduce the number of new cases of type 2 diabetes by 58%, and 71% in adults over the age of 60.

DESCRIPTION

- One-year program
 - 25 sessions
- Small group, supportive environment
- Classroom based
 - Can be offered in any community setting
- Learn about healthier eating & increasing physical activity to reduce risk

GOALS

- Reduce body weight by 5-7%
- Increase physical activity to 150 minutes per week

WHO QUALIFIES

- Adults 18+
- Overweight (BMI ≥ 25)*
- At risk for or have been diagnosed with **PREDIABETES**[†]
 - Via a blood test with one of the following results
 - Fasting Plasma Glucose between 100–125 mg/dL
 - 2-hour Plasma Glucose between 140–199 mg/dL
 - A1c between 5.7% and 6.4%
 - Or a previous diagnosis of gestational diabetes
 - If a blood test is not available, a qualifying risk score based on a combination of risk factors—family history, age, etc.

"Everything we were learning just clicked and while my weight is far from where I'd like it to be, my A1c went down from 6.1 to 5.6 which is huge! Also, y cholesterol went down about 70 points—enough that my doctor asked if we'd started anything to lower my cholesterol. That was a big win for me!"

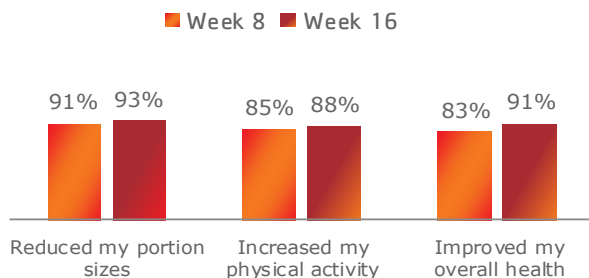

By the end of January 2018, the YMCA’s Diabetes Prevention Program had **served over 58,000 participants** at nearly 1,700 sites in 46 states across the country.

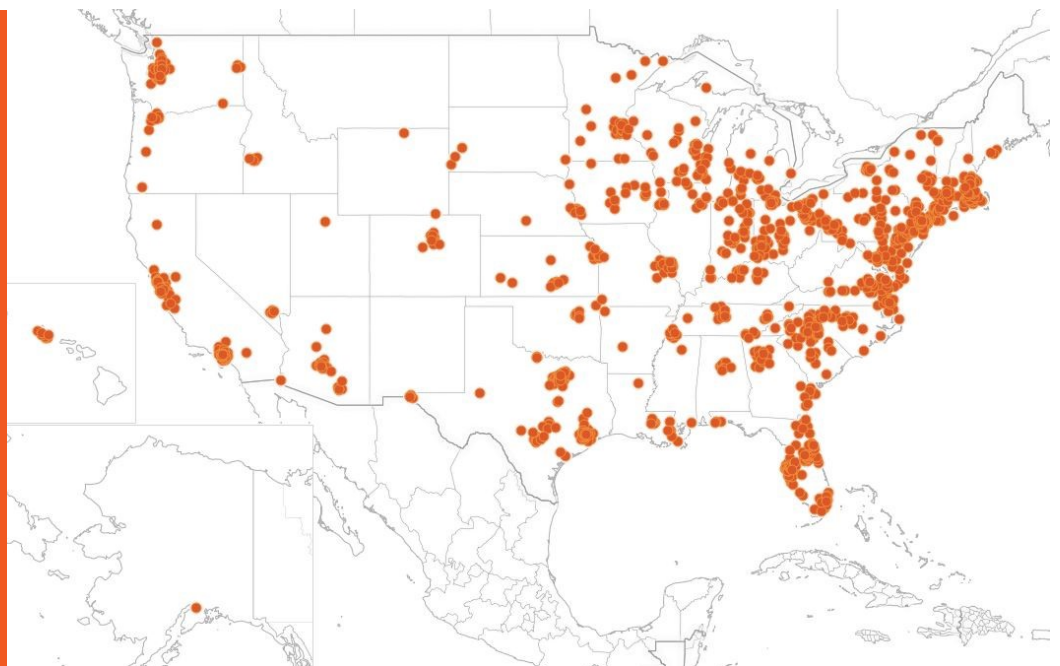
- The YMCA's Diabetes Prevention Program uses a CDC-approved curriculum and is part of the CDC-led National Diabetes Prevention Program.

"I had received phone calls from the nurses at Anthem Blue Cross/Blue Shield, asking me if I knew I was in danger of becoming diabetic and I received a postcard in the mail, informing me that my health insurance would cover the cost of the Diabetes Prevention Program (DPP) classes. Memories of my mom, a type 1 diabetic, came flooding back—her daily insulin shots, strict diet and daily walks after supper. She managed her disease well but the medical knowledge of the day was not enough—she died at age 51 in 1982 from diabetic complications. When the DPP started, I learned no food is off limits, but I did have to use portion control and to accept this is a lifestyle change that will have to be maintained for the rest of my life. New challenges were saying no to too much food at work and church potlucks. My lifestyle coach was friendly and helpful but firm—she wanted to see me succeed. I lost 27.4 lbs in the first 16 weeks. My blood glucose is now in the normal range, but I can't afford to go back to my old ways of eating. I will always be a high-risk patient because of my family history of diabetes, age and high blood pressure.
